I give Cross Road Children's Center permission to photograph and use photographs of my children in the development of videos, published materials or news releases with the understanding that our privacy will be respected and honored. I also give teachers and student's permission to photograph or video my child for the purposes of classroom assignments. Photographs may also be used for parent information on the Internet through www.crossroadks.org and social media.

3. I understand that if my child is totally unable to function in a group setting, he/she may be asked to undergo diagnostic assessment and may be referred to another agency for assistance. If these resources are not able to provide the necessary assistance, alternative sources for care will be suggested.

4. I understand that Cross Road Children's Center will strive to provide high quality care for my child. I know that I am encouraged to observe and participate in my child's classroom at any time and am expected to communicate daily with the staff.
